ROUND OF INDIVIDUAL SHOOTING TO DETERMINE
THE TOP 10 MALE AND FEMALE MARKSMEN OF THE
YEAR.

THIS YEAR, ANDERSON SECONDARY SCHOOL NPCC UNIT SENT 2 TEAMS (MALE & FEMALE) TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION, I WAS HONOURED TO BE PART OF THE BOYS TEAM TOGETHER WITH RYAN CHOO, CLEMENT LEE, KOH JUN AN AND SOO JUN NENG. THE GIRLS TEAM CONSISTED OF JOCELYN TAN, GERMAINE PANG, LING LI WEN, TAN ZHU JIA AND MARCIA ZHANG.
